**Re: E-Learning and Kids Club Program**

Dear Parents:

To those parents who responded to our digital survey that was prepared and sent in record time, let us say thank you. The responses and feedback was critical in helping the WPD navigate the need for and planning of this new program that is in response to your needs, and the needs of your student, during this most challenging time. Clearly many of you do need assistance with the care of your child during this unusual school day. Because of the survey results we are confident in our efforts to forge ahead and serve you when the school year begins Monday, August 31st.

The WPD understands that District 60 has pivoted moving to 100% remote learning to start the school year. Our proposed program may help you navigate care for your child during this challenging time. Please let it be clear, the extended E-learning Program will be presented as a stand-alone program separate from our traditional before and after school Kids Club Program. Our Kids Club program will still be offered same as last year. Both the Kids Club and Extended E-Learning programs are available to students K-5.

## **Extended E-Learning Program Details**

- E-learning day will be 9am-3pm at the Westmont Park District Community Center.
- Temperature checks will be performed each day at the beginning of the day.
- 6' Social distancing seating assignments will be implemented for E-Learning and other miscellaneous activities.
- Rooms 1-4, Kids Club Room, gymnasium and playground at Veterans Memorial Park will be available for use by participants. The Richmond Room and lounge in the basement of the Administrative Center will also be available as overflow space if necessary.
- Minimum 12/ maximum 36 students (it is possible that the program may be increased to 48 students but not guaranteed).
- WPD staff will proctor and supervise the children's e-learning experience though it is not responsible for the success or failure of the student's experience.
- Daytime E-Learning will be conducted per School District 60's plan and recommendations to be sent under separate cover.
- WPD staff will advise District 60 faculty of any students in its Extended E-Learning Program who may be struggling with the E-Learning curriculum.
- Registration will go live Monday morning August 17<sup>th</sup>.
